 - a. What are the different elements of this passage that highlight God's excellence, supremacy, and greatness over and above His creation?
- 3. According to Travis, what's a simple way to define the biblical concept of "holiness?"
 - a. Before listening to this sermon, how would you have defined holiness?
 - b. How does this definition of holiness challenge or reshape the way you typically think about holiness?
 - c. What then does it mean that God makes us holy?
- 4. What does then does it look like to treat God as holy versus something common or impure?
- 5. What are some ways that you are tempted to treat God as if He wasn't as holy as He truly is?
- 6. When do you (or have you) seen God's holiness most clearly?
 - a. How does it (has it) affected you and your behavior?
