

Ps. 91 Discussion Questions

Read Psalm 91

1. The Psalmist uses a lot of different images to describe God's protection of his people. Which of them stand out to you? Which can you relate to? (In other words, what is your "terror in night" or what are your "arrows in the noonday?")
2. In what areas do you struggle to trust in the Lord's care for you? Why?
3. What besides the Lord are you tempted to try and abide in for protection? Why do you tend to trust in these things?
4. Pastor Mike suggested that God's protection applies to both our physical and spiritual lives.
 - a. If this is true, then how do we make sense of the fact that God often permits us to endure both physical and spiritual hardships?
 - b. What does this reveal about the nature of God's protection and what we should expect to the Lord's protection to look like now?
4. This Psalm teaches that those who "abide" in the Lord enjoy his protection.
 - a. What does it mean to abide in the Lord?
 - b. What hinders your abiding?
5. Where have you lacked gratitude for the Lord's protection and deliverance?
