4. When it comes to the specifics of how all of us play a part in church planting, Mike gave us three things: you pray, you give and you go.
 - a. Which of those is the easiest and most compelling for you and why?

 - b. Which is the hardest and why?

5. When you heard Mike share the different versions of people to go what did it make you think about?
 - a. Was there one of them that you identified with? In which way?
